Tuition Plans and Policies for 2010-2011

TUITION PLAN A

For active and practicing Catholic families who also participate fully in our Gift Certificate Program:

One child: \$2,300 Two children: \$4,300 Three or more children: \$6,300

“Active and practicing Catholic families” are those who attend Mass regularly and contribute at least \$8.00 weekly in the Sunday offertory (annual total of \$400 in offertory from May 1 to April 30). Active and practicing Catholic families also qualify for scholarship aid from Sunday offertory and from our School Endowment Trust (approximately \$1,100 in scholarship aid per child).

St. Charles Parish offers the Gift Certificate Program for those who choose to participate. It is a scholarship aid fund-raiser. School families who participate receive a direct \$30 return in the form of a check for every \$3,000 of certificates purchased. Encourage your family, friends, and neighbors to participate.

TUITION PLAN B

For those families who choose not to participate in the Gift Certificate Program:

One child: \$2,550 Two children: \$4,800 Three or more children: \$7,050

TUITION PLAN C

For those not attending Mass, not using offertory envelopes totaling \$400 per year, and not participating in the Gift Certificate Program:

\$3,650 per child

TUITION POLICIES

- *There are no school sponsored fund raisers involving St. Charles students. There is no book fee, playground fee, technology fee or library fee;
- * A student is considered registered (or re-registered) for the upcoming school year when a **\$25 non-refundable registration fee per child** (maximum \$75) and a completed registration form is received by the School Office.
- * Smart Tuition will once again handle the collection of all tuition payments for the 2010-11 school year. A \$43 fee (per family) will be charged to those utilizing this service.
 - * A 5% discount will be given if tuition is paid in full by May 31, 2010.
- * The School and Parish Business Office reserve the right to withhold transcripts, report cards, diplomas, and student seat assignments until all financial obligations are paid in full.
